

## Instructions for Local NMI President's Report (XL-4)

1. Report NMI membership. (Include Adult, Youth, and Children.)
  - a. NMI members—members of the Church of the Nazarene. (Give this number to your pastor for his/her report.)
  - b. NMI associate members—non-church members. (Give this number to your pastor.)
  - c. For total NMI members, add 1a and 1b.
  - d. Total NMI members reported last year should be available from the previous year's report or from the previous year's district journal.
  - e. Net gain/loss: If the total membership is more this year than last year, you have a net gain (+). If your membership this year is less than that reported last year, you have a net loss (-).
2. **Yes or No.** Did your church pray for missions any time during the year?
3. **Yes or No.** Did your church participate in **all 5** global awareness categories?
  - a. Used **global awareness resources** (i.e., adult, youth, or children's mission education and/or *International Mission Education Journal*).
  - b. Promoted **NMI missions books/tapes/CDs**. Report the number of books read.
  - c. Participated in **missions service projects** (such as Work & Witness, Youth in Mission, Youthserve, CAUSE, Nazarene Compassionate Ministries centers, Good Samaritan churches, community projects, etc.) and/or **hands-on missions activities** (Crisis Care Kits, School Pal-Paks, relief shipments, LINKS packages, unofficial LINKS, etc.)
  - d. Attended one or more services with a **missions speaker** (local, zone/area, district, and/or regional events; faith promise) and/or provided interaction with a missions speaker (district teen/children's camps, missions events, district NMI convention, missions workshops, etc.).
  - e. Used **multimedia missions resources** (such as *World Mission DVD*, missions Web sites, videos, Nazarene Communications News, etc.) and/or utilized **missions publications and communications** (such as *Mission Connection*, *Global Glimpses*, *Nazarene Compassionate Ministries* magazine, *Holiness Today*, missionaries' newsletters, regional newsletters, etc.).
4. **Yes or No.** Did your church involve children/youth in missions?
5. **Yes or No.** Did your church pay WEF in Full? Check with your church treasurer and pastor.
6. If you marked **Yes** on 2, 3, 4, and 5, then mark **Yes**, you are a Mission Priority One church.
7. Check with your local NMI or church treasurer.
8. Check with your local NMI or church treasurer.

  - a. Check with your local NMI or church treasurer.
  - b. Number of individual packages sent to missionaries and/or mission fields. (If none, show 0.)
10. Check with your local NMI or church treasurer.
11. Alabaster offering is promoted in February and September. Any amount received is counted as participation.
12. World Mission Broadcast offering is promoted in June. Any amount received is counted as participation.

  - a. Nazarene Compassionate Ministries (NCM) is promoted in December. (NCM Fund, Child Sponsorship, Crisis Care Kits, Hot Lunch Programs, disaster response, etc., count as participation.)
  - b. Report number of Crisis Care Kits sent.
  - c. Report number of School Pal-Paks sent.
